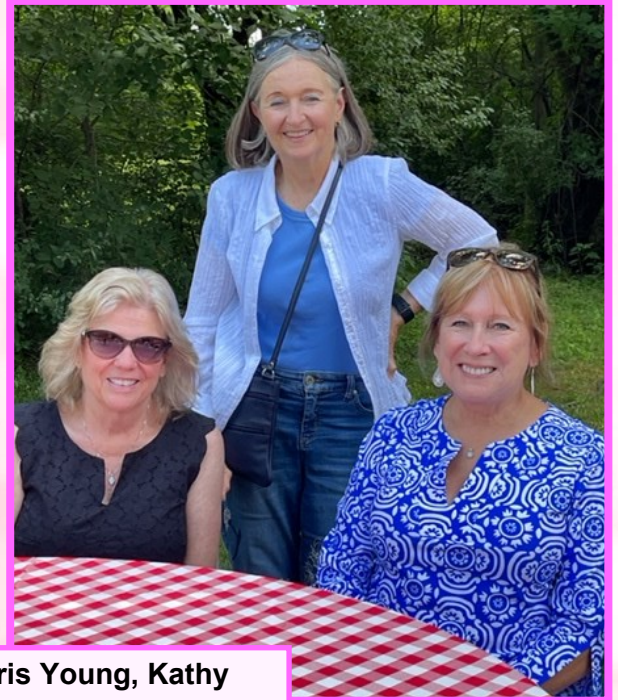
Leaguers Who Lunch

Youth Orchestras

Practices begin September 12 with Monday night check-ins at 3:30 p.m. at Perrysburg Junior High School. Students must register at every practice and at the rehearsal before each concert. League volunteers are needed to help with the registration process every Monday, so if you are able to commit to several hours every Monday, please contact Beth Williams or Kimberly Danes.

Young People's Concerts

League volunteers have warmly greeted thousands of students over the past several decades (first at the Stranahan Theater, then moved to the Toledo Museum of Art Peristyle) as they get off the buses, enter the Peristyle Lobby, then guide them safely to the exit after the concerts and direct them to their buses.

Neither rain, sleet, snow, or ice have kept us from our tasks. This last season, League ushers coordinated logistics outside for two back-to-back concerts on three different dates. We no longer usher inside like we used to do. As our members age, it has become increasingly difficult to find ushers who are able to be outside in all types of weather. As Chair, I recommended that the League discontinue the logistical coordination at these concerts.

Thank you to every member who has helped in any way during the decades of volunteering at these concerts. It has been my pleasure to serve you as chair.
