Remembrance Fund scholarship auditions were held March 11 & 12 at Symphony Space. Three judges were secured for the competition: **Diana Dyer Anderson, Jane Anderson, and Alan Smith**. The judges used a new computer program called Acceptd to record their evaluations and comments for each participant. There were 53 TSYO members who auditioned over the two days: three concert strings students, 15 symphonic students, 22 philharmonic students, and 13 seniors.

Thank you to our Toledo Symphony League volunteers who helped the competition run smoothly. They were Liz Villarreal-Rowe, Kimberly Danes, Ruth Moeller, Helen Patton, Kathy Scheer, Marcia Helman, and Beth Williams.

All TSYO members who auditioned were notified by mail with the judges' comments and if they will receive a scholarship. The seniors who will receive a scholarship won't find out until the May 8 concert when the scholarships are awarded. It was kept a secret from the seniors in the past, so the committee decided to go back to keeping it a secret. There will be a scholarship presented in memory of **Joni Fought's** mother, **Betty Britten**, and in honor of **Janet Keener, Dorothy Coats,** and **Dorothy Bonser**, for all they did for the Remembrance Fund in the past.

The total amount awarded will be increased by \$1,000 due to the voided uncashed check from one of last year's recipients, so the total we will be able to award is \$20,700.


